

## CCF-3914 Leith Schools Project Erratum

The individual components contributing to the total estimated lifetime carbon savings were correctly reported as:

- 432.72 kgCO<sub>2e</sub> (through reducing food waste; target 33.1 tCO<sub>2e</sub>)
- 24.5 tCO<sub>2e</sub> (through increasing composting; target 4.1 tCO<sub>2e</sub>)
- 33.7 tCO<sub>2e</sub> (through increasing the growing of food; target 1.8 tCO<sub>2e</sub>)
- 24.22 tCO<sub>2e</sub> (through encouraging more responsible shopping; target 70.2 tCO<sub>2e</sub>)

However, the total carbon savings were erroneously calculated to have been 515.14 tCO<sub>2e</sub>. (This is obviously because the first figure was misread as being in tonnes and not kilogrammes.) The correct total is **82.85 tCO<sub>2e</sub>**, which means that we fell slightly short of our overall target of 109.2 tCO<sub>2e</sub>.

While this is disappointing, note that the total estimated lifetime carbon savings from this project and its sister project which ran in parallel (CCF-2708 Leith Community Food Project), summed to 712.8 tCO<sub>2e</sub>, still greatly exceeding the joint target of 217.1 tCO<sub>2e</sub>.
